**Introductory remarks by Hon. Rohitha Bogollagama, Minister of
Foreign Affairs of Sri Lanka and the Chair of the 8th ACD Ministerial
Meeting, 15th October 2009**

Your Excellencies,

Distinguished delegates,

Good afternoon.

As Chair of the 8th ACD Ministerial Meeting, may I once again extend a warm welcome, Your Excellencies and distinguished delegates, to the Retreat today. I wish all of you a pleasant and productive stay in Sri Lanka. I look forward to working closely with all of you, in keeping with the spirit of friendship and cooperation.

The Chair of the Prime and Co-Prime Mover Consultations has reported to me that the Group which met on Wednesday, 14th October 2009 had wide ranging discussions covering all areas of cooperation with particular emphasis on the areas of environmental education, energy, poverty alleviation, IT development, SME development and e-education.

In particular, they have agreed that in future when announcing projects in the ACD Calendar of Events, all aspects, including financial viability and implementability, should be fully considered.

They have also emphasized the need to promote trade and investment among ACD Member States, and in this regard, agreement has been reached on paying special attention to the following:

- ACD Trade and Investment Forum could be formed to encourage private sector involvement in stimulating trade and investment. This Forum where Chamber representatives of ACD Member States will be participating among others, could meet at the time of the ACD Ministerials.
- ACD should play a role in asserting Asia's regional space at this time when the rest of the world is eagerly observing Asia's rapid economic recovery and the lead provided by the region for the global economic recovery process.
- ACD should look for inclusive global institutions and an economic structure that would make the world less vulnerable to global economic downfalls.

The Meeting has also taken note of the potential for co-operation in Tourism, Transport and Trade to promote people-to-people contact.

Having briefed you on these developments, I wish now to take this opportunity to place on record my sincere appreciation to the senior officials of the Prime and Co-Prime Mover Consultations for the excellent work they have done in preparing the draft Colombo Declaration for our consideration. I am thankful to the Chairman of Prime and Co-Prime Mover Consultations, Mr. C. R. Jayasinghe, Foreign Secretary of Sri Lanka for steering consultations to a successful conclusion.

I also would like to commend the members of the Coordinating Group comprising of Thailand, Kazakhstan, Iran and Sri Lanka for their constructive engagement and dedicated work.

I would be failing in my duty if I do not thank the Coordinator, the Royal Thai Government, for their unstinted support and guidance, which made our preparations for this Ministerial Meeting in Colombo smoother. My thanks also go to the Republic of Kazakhstan for sharing their experiences.
